

TOP 10 STEPS FOR VISITORS TO TAKE DURING A HURRICANE EVACUATION

- 1. Contact your airline to determine if you can leave prior to the storm's arrival.
- 2. Seek alternative options to depart the area by train, bus or automobile if air travel is not an option.
- 3. Evacuate/depart early as roads may become congested and driving conditions may deteriorate.
- 4. Check with your hotel for assistance with accommodations in non-evacuation zones if you cannot depart the area.
- 5. Advise family and friends you are moving to a new location.
- 6. Monitor local media as storm conditions can change rapidly.
- 7. Make sure you have enough cash on hand for immediate needs.
- 8. Keep cell phone charged since phone systems may not be operational after the storm.
